The American Community School of Abu Dhabi invites aspiring Emirati teachers to apply for a teaching internship program for the school year 2024-25.

SUMMARY OF THE PROGRAM

The ACS Emirati Teaching Internship is designed for **Emirati citizens** who seek to gain hands-on experience in American curriculum and approaches to teaching and learning. Interns will develop their skills under the guidance of experienced mentor educators through a structured program that aims to develop educators who are reflective practitioners able to take a child-centered, holistic approach in the classroom. Programming will be aligned with the <u>UAE's Teacher Standards</u>, the United States National Board for Professional Teaching Standards' <u>Five Core Propositions</u>, and ACS' <u>core values</u> and <u>teacher profile</u>. Successful program completion will position interns to apply for teaching positions in private schools.

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES are **Emirati citizens** who have earned a Bachelor's or Master's Degree in a related teaching field and who demonstrate English language proficiency. In addition, candidates should demonstrate:

- o Passion for Education: A genuine interest in fostering the academic and personal growth of students.
- High Expectations: Belief in the potential of all students to succeed and a commitment to helping them achieve their best.

A Reflective Practice and Continuous Improvement

- Self-Reflection: Regularly evaluates personal teaching practices and seeks feedback for improvement.
- Lifelong Learning: Commitment to ongoing professional development and staying informed about educational research and innovations.
- o Critical Thinking: Ability to analyze educational challenges and develop creative solutions.

• Collaboration and Communication

- Teamwork: Works collaboratively with colleagues, sharing ideas and resources.
- Effective Communication: Strong verbal and written communication skills, with the ability to convey ideas clearly and constructively.
- Community Engagement: Builds positive relationships with parents, colleagues, and the broader community.

• A Desire for Professional Growth

- o Initiative: Takes proactive steps to enhance professional skills and knowledge.
- Mentorship and Support: Willingness to learn from mentors and provide support to peers.

Awareness of Cultural Competence and Inclusivity

- Cultural Awareness: Understands and respects the cultural backgrounds of students and incorporates this awareness into teaching practices.
- o Inclusivity: Strives to create an inclusive classroom where all students feel valued and supported.
- Equity: Committed to promoting equity and ensuring all students have access to quality education.

- Engage in programmatic learning experiences facilitated by ACS staff.
- Experience a range of teaching duties typical of full-time faculty.
- Partner with a mentor teacher to plan and implement lessons and units of study and prepare materials for subject-specific, division-level, and school-wide events.
- Work with identified students and groups across the grade level based on needs, supporting student learning and behavior during whole class lessons.
- Document learning through the creation of a digital portfolio
